### Tur Programı

**Gün 1 — Gaziantep, Historical Copper Bazaar, Almacı Bazaar, Yemenciler Arastası, Tahmis Coffee House, Gaziantep Castle, Zeugma Museum, Halfeti Boat Tour, Balıklıgöl, Şanlıurfa Bazaars, Ayn Zeliha Lake, Hz. Ibrahim, Şanlıurfa Sıra Night**

On the 1st Day of Our Boutique Gaziantep Urfa Mardin Diyarbakır Gap Tour Departing from Izmir, after meeting our valued guests at Sabiha Gökçen Airport at the relevant airline counter, we perform Check-In procedures for the SunExpress Airlines flight from Izmir to Gaziantep with ID Card or Driver's License. (Note: Your guide will meet you at Gaziantep Airport.) After approximately 1.45 hours of flight, we arrive at Gaziantep Airport and meet with our guide and vehicle waiting for us, starting our tour with an extra Breakfast that we will have in one of the famous places of Gaziantep, Zeugma Cafe. Our first sightseeing points will be the Gaziantep Castle and the 14 Martyrs Monument built in memory of the children who died in the 2023 Kahramanmaraş earthquake. Since restoration work is still ongoing at Gaziantep Castle, the castle visit will take place panoramically. Then we will see the Copper Bazaar, Yemenciler Arastası, Almacı Bazaar, and Tahmis Coffee House. During our free time here, you can enjoy Menengiç Coffee. After completing our historical bazaar tours in Gaziantep, we provide an opportunity to shop at Ayıntap Baklava, the most famous baklava shop in Gaziantep, the city that first comes to mind when it comes to Baklava in Turkey. After that, we will visit the Zeugma Mosaic Museum, where the floor mosaics of Roman generals' villas are exhibited, rescued from the submerged City of Zeugma. After seeing the Çingene Kızı and other mosaics, we head towards Halfeti. Most of Halfeti, which is submerged under the waters of the Birecik Dam, is also the location where the Karagül series was filmed. We will board our boat for an approximately 1-hour (Extra) Boat Tour, where we will see the King's Daughter Cave, the Rum Castle where one of Jesus' apostles, John, settled, and then the submerged Mosque and minaret in the Fighting Village. After the Halfeti visit, we turn our direction towards Şanlıurfa. First, we go to (extra) Ciğerhan Restaurant for lunch. After the meal, we will return to Şanlıurfa, known as the City of Prophets, where it is believed that Prophets Adam, Job, Abraham, Shuayb, and Elyasa lived, and we will visit Balıklı Göl (Halil-Ül Rahman Lake), the Ayn-ı Zeliha Lake, which is said to be formed from the tears of King Nimrod's daughter Zeliha, and the cave where Hz. Ibrahim was born. Finally, we will go to Arda İso Saray to shop for products such as isot, tomato paste, pomegranate molasses, and illegal tea. After shopping, we head to our hotel for accommodation, and for those guests who wish, we participate in the Sıra Night, which is essential for experiencing the regional culture and tasting local foods. (Extra - Dinner Included) Dinner during our accommodation this evening is not included in the tour price. Guests who do not want to participate in the Sıra Night can have dinner at their own expense.

**Gün 2 — Göbeklitepe Viranşehir, Mardin, Kasımiye Medresesi, Abbaralar, Deyruzafaran Monastery, Diyarbakır Gate, Abbaralar, Tellallar Bazaar, Şehidiye Mosque, Şahtana Mansion, Old Mardin Bazaars, Savur Gate,**

On the 2nd Day of Our Boutique Gaziantep Urfa Mardin Diyarbakır Gap Tour Departing from Izmir, after breakfast at our hotel, we first turn our direction towards Göbeklitepe to witness history and take a short journey through time with our guide's explanations. We set off towards Mardin via Viranşehir Kızıltepe. First, we stop in Mardin for lunch. The place known as "Gecesi Gerdanlık, Gündüzü Seyranlık" will be our first sightseeing point, which is the Kasımiye Medresesi. After enjoying this magnificent structure and listening to our guide's explanations, we will go to the Deyr-ul Zaferan Monastery, which was the residence of Syriac Orthodox patriarchs for 640 years. Here we will visit the House of Saints, which contains the graves of 52 patriarchs and metropolitans, Saint Hananyo Church, and Mary Mother Church. Then we will move towards Old Mardin and get off our vehicle at Diyarbakır Gate. From here, we will take minibuses (extra). We will see the Sheikh Çabuk Mosque, which is known to be the grave of Abdullah Bin Enes El Cüheyri, the messenger of Hz. Muhammad, from the outside, and get off the minibuses at Republic Square. After seeing the Ulu Mosque, which is famous for its minaret built by Armenian Master Lole in 1176 and renovated during the reign of II. Abdulhamid in 1889, and the Abbaralar, which provide arched passages between the streets, we will have free time where guests can see the Şahtana Mansion, which is an old Armenian mansion known as the Old PTT Building, and the Şehidiye Mosque, which is believed to have been built by Sultan Melik Nasreddin Artuk Aslan in the early 13th century. After our break, we will meet with our vehicle at Savur Gate and return to our hotel. Dinner and accommodation will be at our hotel.

### **Gün 3 — Dara Ancient City, Midyat, Sıla Mansion, Hasankeyf, Zeynelbey Tomb, Batman, Malabadi Bridge, Diyarbakır Ulu Mosque, Mardin Gate, Airport**

On the 3rd Day of Our Boutique Gaziantep Urfa Mardin Diyarbakır Gap Tour Departing from Izmir, after breakfast at our hotel, we will depart from Mardin and head towards another visual feast point, Midyat. If there is sufficient time and participation, our guide may organize an (Extra) Dara Ancient City tour. Here we will visit the Guest House, which hosted the Sıla series, and take a short break to see and shop for the famous Telkari art of Midyat. During this time, we will go to Saide Mısır Çarşısı to shop for Blue Almond Candy dyed with the root of the Lahor tree. After our shopping time here, our journey will take us to Hasankeyf, which has been submerged under the waters of the Ilisu Dam. We will see the Zeynel Bey Tomb and other historical artifacts in their new locations. After the visit to Hasankeyf, we will have lunch at Meşhur Ali Usta in Batman (Extra). After our meal break, we will turn our direction towards Diyarbakır and with the participation of all guests, an Extra tour of the Malabadi Bridge will be organized. After our extra tour, we will reach Diyarbakır. We will view the Diyarbakır Walls and Urfa Gate, which is known to have a history of 9000 years, panoramically from our vehicle with our guide's explanations. We will visit the Diyarbakır Ulu Mosque, one of the oldest mosques in Anatolia, which was converted into a mosque in 639 and is one of the V. Haram Sharifs. We will meet with our vehicle at Mardin Gate, one of the four main gates of the Diyarbakır walls, and see the Hevsel Gardens, which are believed to lead to Paradise, as well as the Keçi Burcu and On Gözlü Bridge panoramically before reaching the Airport. We will perform our flight with the relevant airlines from Diyarbakır or Batman - Izmir Adnan Menderes Airport. We complete our Boutique Gaziantep Urfa Mardin Diyarbakır Gap Tour from Izmir, leaving behind dozens of memories that will remain in your minds.
