Tur Programı

Gün 1 — Cat House - Van Castle - Gagik Church - Akdamar Boat Tour — Van Hotels

We meet at Adnan Menderes Airport at least 2 hours before the flight time to start a wonderful holiday with our valued guests and check in for the Van flight with Sun Express Airlines. After approximately 2 hours and 10 minutes of flight, we meet our guide waiting for us at Van Airport and start our Izmir Departure Flight Included Caucasus Triangle Eastern Express Van Nakhchivan Kars Tour. We go to Ahtamara Organic Breakfast to enjoy Van's famous breakfast and start the day with Van breakfast (Extra). After our Van Breakfast break, we learn about the Savat Art made with black clay, an alloy obtained from copper, lead, and sulfur, which comes from the Arabic word "Esvad" meaning "black." After seeing the rare breed of cats known as Van Cats, we panoramically observe Van Castle, built between 840-825 BC by Urartian King I. Sarduri, which overlooks the Urartian capital Tuşpa, with a length of 1800 m, a width of 120 m, and a height of 80 m. After leaving Van, we board our boat in Gevaş, located at the foot of the extinct volcano Artos at an altitude of 3550 m, and with our guide, we will take a 30-minute journey on Lake Van, which is salty and soda-rich, with an altitude of 1646 m, a width of 120 km, and a height of 80 km, reaching Akdamar Island. After visiting the Gagik Church, built between 915-921 by King I. Gagik of Vaspurakan, we complete our boat tour (Extra) and return to Gevaş. We go to the Urartian Carpet point in Van to learn about the region's carpet weaving. After a short break, we visit Akdamar Cheese Shop, where you can find unique flavors such as Karakovan Honey, Van Herb Cheese, Goat Butter, and Buffalo Cheese, and take a shopping break. After completing our shopping, we board our bus and head to our hotel. We arrive at our hotel in Van. Dinner and accommodation will be at our hotel. Breakfast: Van - Ahtamara / Van Breakfast (Extra) Lunch: Grand Deniz Restaurant İnci Kefali (Extra) Dinner: Will be taken at the hotel (Included) Accommodation: Van Hotels - Reform Hotel, etc....

Gün 2 — Doğubeyazıt - Iğdır - Han Palace - War Museum - Bazaar — Azerbaijan Nakhchivan Hotels

On the 2nd Day of our Flight Included Caucasus Triangle Eastern Express Van Nakhchivan Kars Tour, after breakfast at our hotel, we will take a photo break at Muradiye Waterfall, which is approximately 50 m high and named after Sultan IV. Murat, who went on the Baghdad expedition, located on the Bend-i Mahi River. After our break, we will reach Doğubeyazıt, which has continuously developed as a Customs Center, crossing the Tendürek Pass on the Trabzon road chart, with a name similarity to Çaldıran, located near the city of Maku within the Iranian borders. The İshakpaşa Palace, which was started to be built in 1685 by Çıldır Atabek Çolak Abdi Pasha and completed in 1784 during the time of Küçük İshak Pasha, who came from the same lineage 99 years later, is the first structure in the world to use a wall-central heating system with 366 rooms. We will see the Milk Fountain, which is said to have milk flowing from one tap and water from another, the Court Room, the Dungeons, the Harem, and the Selamlık part, and have our lunch break at Beyzade Restaurant in Doğubeyazıt. After our break, we will pass by Mount Ararat, which became operational for the last time in 1840, and reach Iğdır, which takes its name from Deniz Han, the eldest son of one of the six sons of Oğuz Han. Here, we turn our direction to the Dilucu Border Gate, which is the easternmost point of Turkey. On our way, we will take panoramic photos of the Iğdır Genocide Monument, built in memory of the Turkish martyrs who were massacred by Armenians. Upon arrival at the border gate, we first pass through the Turkish customs with our IDs and then board the shuttles (Extra) to reach the Nakhchivan customs area. Here, we also pass through ID control and board our vehicle on the other side, starting our journey, which will take approximately 1 hour. On our way, we will see the Monument Panels with the photos and names of the martyrs. When we arrive in Nakhchivan Center, our first sightseeing point will be the Heydar Aliyev Museum, where we will take photos after receiving information from our guide, followed by the Mömüne Hatun Tomb, a Seljuk structure, and the Han Palace Museum. The HES built over the Aras River in front of us will also present a visual feast. After our tour and photo break, we will move to see Haydar Mosque (Green Mosque), and then we will go to Clock Square, one of the largest squares in the city, where we will take a photo break before returning to our vehicle. Our next stop in this city, which will attract your attention with its wide roads and cleanliness, will be the War Museum, which we will see panoramically. After that, we will go to the Bayraklı Tepe Museum, which is located at a point dominating the city with the giant Azerbaijan Flag waving, and after taking a photo break here, we will reach the Bazaar for your shopping. After our break, we will go to Zümrüt Restaurant for dinner. After our meal, we board our vehicle to head to our hotel. Accommodation will be at our hotel. Note: According to the agreement made between the Republic of Turkey and Azerbaijan, Turkish citizens can cross into Nakhchivan with a New Identity Card or Passport that has a TC identity number. Crossing is not allowed with other identity cards (driver's license, institutional IDs, etc.). Guests under 18 who will not travel with both parents must obtain a notarized consent letter for crossing into Nakhchivan. It is mandatory for all identity documents, including babies and children, to have a photo. WARNING: DO NOT FORGET TO TAKE YOUR TC ID CARD WITH YOU WHEN TRAVELING. THE EXIT FEE OF 1000 TL WILL BE PAID BY THE GUEST. OFFICIALLY, PASSAGE TO AZERBAIJAN WITH OLD ID CARDS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. Breakfast: Will be taken at the hotel as an open buffet. (Included) Lunch: Doğubeyazıt - Beyzade Restaurant (Extra) Dinner: Will be taken at Zümrüt Restaurant (Included) Accommodation: Nakhchivan - Naxçivan Palace Hotel

Gün 3 — Free Shop Shopping - Kars Ani Ruins - Kars Castle - Stone Bridge

On the 3rd Day of our Flight Included Caucasus Triangle Eastern Express Van Nakhchivan Kars Tour, after having an open buffet breakfast at our hotel in Nakhchivan, we board our vehicles and head towards the Dilucu Border Gate, where we will have the opportunity to shop at the Free Shop while leaving Nakhchivan. After entering Turkey, we board our bus and come to Iğdır, where we will see the Iranian border on one side and the Armenian border on the other, and visit the Tuzluca Cave, named after the salt mine covering an area of 35 acres (Extra). We set off towards Kars, which remained under Russian control for about 40 years after the war known as the 93 War, which took place between 1877-1878, in the direction of Digor, located at the foothills of the volcanic Yağlıca Mountain at an altitude of 2961 m. After reaching Ani, which was the capital of the Armenian Dynasty after leaving Kars, which was handed over to the Ottomans after the Brest-Litovsk Treaty made after the Bolshevik Revolution in 1918, we visit the Picture Church, built by a merchant from Ani named Tigran Honents in 1215, the Great Cathedral, whose foundations were laid by King II. Sembat of the Bagratids in 990 AD but completed in 1001 by his wife Queen Katranide after the king's death, and the Menuçehr Mosque, built in 1072 by Ebû'l Menuçehr Bey, which is the first Turkish mosque in Anatolia. After completing our visits, we arrive in Kars. After visiting the Caucasus Front War History Museum, built in 1803 during the reign of Sultan Selim III under the name

Gün 4 — Eastern Express - Erzurum Congress Building - Atatürk House - Ulu Mosque — Attention! No Accommodation This Night.

On the 4th Day of our Flight Included Caucasus Triangle Eastern Express Van Nakhchivan Kars Tour, after having breakfast at our hotel, we head to the train station (Kars Train Station or Sarıkamış Train Station) at 08:00 for our Eastern Express Train journey towards Erzurum. We arrive in Erzurum, which was connected to the Ottoman Empire by Yavuz Sultan Selim in 1517 and is the gateway to Anatolia. We will have the opportunity to enjoy the famous Çağ Kebab in Erzurum. After our lunch break, we will visit the Double Minaret Medrese, built by Hundi Hatun, daughter of Alaattin Keykubat, or by Padişah Hatun from the Ilkhanid dynasty, from the outside, and then visit the Ulu Mosque, built in 1179 during the reign of Saltuklu Melik Nasirüddin Muhammed Bey. After shopping for Oltu Stone, known to relieve rheumatic pain and significantly strengthen the nervous system, at the Stone Inn, built by Rüstem Pasha, the grand vizier and also the son-in-law of Sultan Suleiman the Magnificent in 561, we start our journey to Erzurum Airport. We check in for our flight with Sun Express Airlines and begin our flight to Izmir. At the end of our 2-hour journey, we arrive at Adnan Menderes Airport, completing our tour. We conclude our Flight Included Caucasus Triangle Eastern Express Van Nakhchivan Kars Tour, leaving behind dozens of memories that will remain in your minds, and say goodbye until we meet again in another organization.
